## Author Identifiers



In today's crowded scholarly publishing scene mix-ups with similarly-named authors, variants or name changes can easily happen. Persistent identifiers help you claim your identity and distinguish you from others

## Author Identifiers

## Are important because:

- It reduces author ambiguity
- It helps to manage career changes
- It supports administrative efficiency
- It improves the research impact
- It promotes networking and collaboration

## Author Identifiers

1. ORCID - fully interoperable with PURE and Scopus Author ID.
2. ResearcherID - is connected with the database Web of Science (WoS). The author must have at least one publication in the Web of Science database in order to have ResearcherID.
3. Scopus Author ID - is created automatically when there is at least one publication in the Scopus database. Publications are linked to the author's name automatically.

Due to the various forms of author's names, one author can have more Scopus Author ID.
